

SCHOOL CROSSING GUARD POSITION DESCRIPTION

Description of Position

The School Crossing Guard, under the general supervision of the Principal, provides for the safety of school children who cross in public thoroughfares to and from school.

1. Qualifications

- 1.1 High School graduation or recognized equivalent.
- 1.2 Minimum age 21.
- 1.3 Ability to learn, interpret and enforce school and District rules regarding student behavior and discipline.
- 1.4 Knowledge of First Aid.
- 1.5 Prior work experience with youth, desirable.
- 1.6 Ability to work cooperatively with students, staff, and parents.

2. Duties and Responsibilities

- 2.1 Crosses children at assigned crosswalk; remains in crosswalk until all children have reached opposite side.
- 2.2 Uses STOP paddle for signaling vehicles; wears safety vest or identifiable clothing, for increased visibility and recognition by children and drivers.
- 2.3 Knows and obeys all ordinances regarding vehicle and pedestrian traffic with respect to crosswalks.
- 2.4 Knows rules regarding bicycle safety and pedestrian crossings and ensures that all children and adults comply with rules.
- 2.5 Informs school personnel of any problems or safety concerns at assigned crosswalk.
- 2.6 Performs other duties as assigned.
