Red Status

- Criteria
 - Marin County is on the CA COVID Watch List, Marin County has been off the CA COVID Watch List for less than 14 days, or Marin County Public Health order or guidance
- LCMUSD Distance Learning Instructional Program implemented TK-8
 - Minimum live interaction daily
 - Elementary: 30 minute lessons at three times per day, 10 minute daily expectations meeting, plus small group/individual as needed (teachers spends 100-120 minutes daily with small groups)
 - Middle: 40 minute periods at three times per day, 15 minute homeroom, plus small group as needed (teachers spend 20 minutes after each period in small group)
 - Average of 240+ minutes (180+ minutes for TK/K) of live content and independent practice total per day
- Small group services or assessments as permitted
 - Special education, English Learner, literacy intervention, math intervention



Yellow Status

- Criteria
 - Marin County has been off the CA COVID Watch List for more than 14 days, Marin County Public Health order or guidance, or approved Marin County Public Health Waiver (in consultation with labor, parent and community organizations)
 - Note: if CDC or MCPH permits the transition from Red to Green, Yellow will be implemented for at least one week to phase in Green
- Hybrid
 - Two Tracks (A/B), cohorts with an average of 10-15 students (per guidance) within each Track
 - Three days distance learning
 - Two days in person
 - 6+ feet of social distance student to student, teacher to student, and teacher to adult
 - Average of 240+ minutes (180+ minutes for TK/K) of live content and independent practice total per day
- Small group services or assessments as permitted
 - Special education, English Learner, literacy intervention, math intervention



Green Status

- **Criteria**
 - Marin County has been off the CA COVID Watch List for more than 14 days, Marin County Public Health order or guidance, or approved Marin County Public Health Waiver (in consultation with labor, parent and community organizations)
 - Note: if CDC or MCPH permits the transition from Red to Green, Yellow will be implemented for at least one week to phase in Green
- **Five Days Per Week of In-Person Learning**
 - 240+ instructional minutes per day (170 minutes of in-person instruction and 70 minutes of distance learning)
 - AM/PM cohorts with an average of 10-15 students (8:10-11:00; 12:30-3:20)
 - Cleaning in between cohorts
 - 6+ feet of social distance student to student, teacher to student, and teacher to adult
 - PE, electives, and specials primarily delivered via distance learning
 - Grab and go lunch
- **Small group services or assessments as permitted**
 - Special education, English Learner, literacy intervention, math intervention
